La treizième pierre 2012-12-06 this ebook is comprised of hutton's 1788 paper theory of the earth read before the royal society of edinburgh as well as volumes 1 and 2 of his book of the same name although his books filled with long quotes in french make difficult reading hutton deserves to be better known as one of the makers of the modern view of the earth

Pierre Bayle 1883 feuerbach's work on pierre bayle was not a book or essay but rather a series of lectures he gave in 1842 at the university of erlangen these lectures were later published as pierre bayle ein beitrag zur geschichte der philosophie und menschheit pierre bayle a contribution to the history of philosophy and humanity feuerbach's lectures on pierre bayle highlighted the importance of bayle's contributions to the development of religious tolerance skepticism and literary criticism schopenhauer and nietzsche both take their satirical criticism about religion from feuerbach and every aspect of marxism can be found here in marx's favorite philosopher feuerbach is a critical figure in the development of not merely marxism but materialistic humanism in general this is volume iii in the 2023 the complete works of ludwig feuerbach by newcomb livraria press

Fish and Fisheries 1897 explaining the science contained in a simple assembly of grains the most abundant form of matter present on earth granular media composed of vast amounts of grains consolidated or not constitute the most abundant form of solid matter on earth granular materials assemble in disordered configurations scientists often liken to a bag of marbles made of macroscopic particles rather than molecules they defy the standard scheme of classification in terms of solid liquid and gas granular materials provide a model relevant to various domains of research including engineering physics and biology william blake famously wished to see a world in a grain of sand in this book pioneering researchers in granular matter explain the science hidden behind simple grains shedding light on collective behavior in disordered settings in general the authors begin by describing the single grain with its different origins shapes and sizes then examine grains in piled or stacked form they explain the packing fraction of granular media a crucial issue that bears on the properties displayed in practical applications explore small scale deformations in piles of disordered grains with particular attention to friction and present

theories of various modes of disorder along the way they discuss such concepts as force chains arching effects wet grains sticky contacts and inertial effects drawing on recent numerical simulations as well as classical concepts developed in physics and mechanics the book offers an accessible introduction to a rapidly developing field

Selections from Pierre Loti [pseud.] 1911 bernardin de st pierre 1737 1814 was a major figure of the late french enlightenment in this first full length critical biography of the author in english malcolm cook seeks to understand the importance of bernardin s major works drawing heavily on unpublished manuscript material he provides a fresh account of the writer s significance and status in a period of french history which during bernardin s lifetime saw the transition from monarchy to republic and empire the book is both a critical account of a major author and a source of new insights into the cultural revolution taking place around him

Pierre Gualtier de Varennes, Sieur de la Verendrye 1853 in this volume leading researchers in their fields present their reflections on arabic and more broadly semitic languages as well as their insights on those language systems and representations

Built on Sand 2016-10-05 this book considers the differing emotional investments in israel of on the one hand jews physically domiciled in israel and on the other hand diasporic jews living outside israel for whom the country nonetheless forms a central point of affect the book's purpose is to trace how these two types of investment are represented by francophone jewish writers israel is at once a problematic geopolitical reality in international politics and a salient topos within jewish cultural imaginaries that transcend national boundaries however it has often been claimed that israel has a special relationship with france which until 1967 was its greatest ally israel has a large francophone community some 800 000 while france has the largest jewish community in europe some 600 000 but franco israeli relations have undergone radical largely negative transformations under the fifth republic 1958 the scope of the book is wide addressing the following questions how do francophone jewish writers represent israel in their literary works what responses to the israeli palestinian conflict do they express both in these works and in non literary discourse interviews and journalistic articles what is the role in those responses of emotion affect cognition and ethics to answer these questions the book examines 44 different autobiographies memoirs and novels published between 1965 and 2012 by

27 different authors both male and female covering the full cultural spectrum of jews ashkenazic sephardic and mizrahi the approach of the book is interdisciplinary combining literary analysis with insights from the domains of history journalism philosophy politics psychoanalysis and sociology
