image but to sharpen it and make it more consistent with the new testament and the ancient church though the devotional life is sometimes brushed off as unimportant in comparison to a theological understanding of christ groeschel warns that such dismissal threatens to make distant unknown and obscure the savior who said i am with you always the answer instead is to draw near to jesus in devotion and with authentic expressions of that devotion which themselves help paint the image of christ found concretely in revelation onto the minds and daily life of the devout begun on a pilgrimage to the holy land and the result of years of preparation and a whole life of guiding people as priest public preacher psychologist and spiritual director this book will help catholic orthodox and protestant believers gain not only a comprehensive view of how pious christians over the centuries have lived out their devotion to god but the examples and perspective they need to live more devoutly today
