Annals of Medical History 1925 the year 2013 marks the 50th anniversary of the publication of Erving Goffman's landmark work *Stigma*. Notes on the management of spoiled identity through this edited volume we commemorate the continuing contribution of Goffman's work on stigma to social psychology as Goffman originally used the term stigma implies some sort of negative deviance or in his words an undesired differentness from what we had anticipated since Goffman's pioneering treatise there have been thousands of articles published on different aspects of stigma the accelerating volume of articles is testimony to the growing importance of stigma research with almost three out of four of the stigma related publications in the research literature appearing in the last 10 years in this volume a collection of up and coming and seasoned stigma researchers provide both theoretical insights and new empirical findings the volume should be of interest to both established researchers and advanced students seeking to learn more about the depth and breadth of stigma research this book was originally published as a special issue of *Basic and Applied Social Psychology*

Twelve Catholic Men of Science 1912 the US Antarctic meteorite collection exists due to a cooperative program involving the National Science Foundation (NSF), the National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) and the Smithsonian Institution since 1976 meteorites have been collected by a NSF funded field team shipped for curation, characterization, distribution and storage at NASA and classified and stored for long term at the Smithsonian it is the largest collection in the world with many significant samples including lunar, martian, many interesting chondrites and achondrites and even several unusual one of a kind meteorites from as yet unidentified parent bodies many Antarctic meteorites have helped to define new meteorite groups no previous formal publication has covered the entire collection and an overall summary of its impact and significant samples has been lacking in addition available statistics for the collection are out of date and need to be updated for the use of the community 35 seasons of US Antarctic meteorites 1976-2011 a pictorial guide to the collection is the first comprehensive volume that portrays the most updated key significant meteoritic samples from Antarctica 35 seasons of US Antarctic meteorites presents a broad overview of the program and collection nearly four decades after its beginnings the collection has been a consistent and reliable source of astromaterials for a large, diverse and active scientific community volume highlights include overview of the history, field practices, curation approaches, special focus on specific meteorite types and the impact of the collection on understanding these groups primitive chondrites, differentiated meteorites, lunar and martian meteorites, role of Antarctic meteorites in influencing the determination of space and terrestrial exposure ages for meteorites, statistical summary of the collection by year, region, meteorite type as well as a comparison to modern falls and hot desert finds the central portion of the book features 80 color plates each of which highlights more influential and interesting samples from the collection 35 seasons of US Antarctic meteorites would be of special interest to a multidisciplinary audience in meteoritics including advanced graduate students and geoscientists specializing in mineralogy, petrology, geochemistry, astronomy, near earth object science, astrophysics and astrobiology

but even as a thriving adult Kelly still saw herself as George Corrigan's daughter a garrulous Irish American charmer from Baltimore George was the center of the ebullient raucous Corrigan clan he greeted every day by opening his bedroom window and shouting hello world suffice it to say Kelly's was a colorful childhood just the sort a girl could get attached to Kelly lives deep within what she calls the middle place that sliver of time when parenthood and childhood overlap comfortably wedged between her adult duties and her parents care but she's abruptly shoved into a coming of age when she finds a lump in her breast and gets the diagnosis no one wants to hear and so Kelly's journey to full blown adulthood begins when George too learns he has late stage cancer it is Kelly's turn to take care of the man who had always taken care of her and show us a woman as she finally takes the leap and grows up Kelly Corrigan is a natural born storyteller a gift you quickly recognize as her father's legacy and her stories are rich with everyday details she captures the beat of an ordinary life and the tender sometimes fractious moments that bind families together rueful and honest Kelly is the prized friend who will tell you her darkest lowest screwiest thoughts and then later dance on the coffee table at your party funny yet heart wrenching the middle place is about being a parent and a child at the same time it is about the special double vision you get when you are standing with one foot in each place it is about the family you make and the family you came from and locating navigating and finally celebrating the place where they meet it is about reaching for life with both hands and finding it

The Lakeside Annual Directory of the City of Chicago 1876 historically pharmaceutical and fine chemical products have been synthesised using batch methods but increasingly chemists are looking towards flow chemistry as a greener and more efficient alternative in flow chemistry reactions are performed in a reactor with the reactants pumped through it it has the benefit of being easily scaled up and it is straightforward to integrate synthesis workup and analysis into one system flow chemistry is considered a greener alternative to batch chemistry because it is easier to control and minimise hazardous intermediates and by products there is significant interest in the use of flow chemistry both in the lab and on an industrial scale flow chemistry provides an update on recent advances that have been made in the field particular emphasis is given to the new integrated approaches that bring together several elements to implement flow processes as a regular green chemistry tool for the chemical industries with chapter contributions from several well known experts in the field this book is a valuable resource for researchers working in green chemistry and synthesis chemical engineers and industrial chemists working in the pharmaceutical and fine chemicals industries

House documents 1894 this volume aims to overcome sub disciplinary boundaries in the study of linguistic variation be it language internal or cross linguistic even though dialectologists register analysts typologists and quantitative linguists all deal with linguistic variation there is astonishingly little interaction across these fields but the fourteen contributions in this volume show that these subdisciplines actually share many interests and methodological concerns in common the chapters specifically converge in the following ways first they all seek to explore linguistic variation within or across languages second they are based on usage data that is on corpora of more or less authentic text or speech of different languages or language varieties third all chapters are concerned with the joint analysis also sometimes known as aggregation or data synthesis of multiple phenomena features or measurements of some sort and lastly the contributors all marshal quantitative analysis techniques to analyse the data in short the volume explores the text feature aggregation pipeline in variation studies demonstrating that there is much mutual inspiration to be had by
