basic skills tests based on the national standards for adult basic skills were carried out between June 2002 and May 2003 on a sample of over eight thousand adults normally resident in England. The tests were combined with a background questionnaire social survey. This report provides many detailed statistics but some of the main findings are noted below: 44 per cent of the respondents achieved level 2 or above in the literacy assessment but 16 per cent were classified at entry level 3 in the numeracy test. 25 per cent achieved level 2 or above but 47 per cent were classified at entry level 3 or below. Overall 47 per cent were classified at entry level 3 or below in either literacy or numeracy and only 18 per cent achieved level 2 or above for both literacy and numeracy.
