Tempel der ägyptischen Götter in Griechenland und an der Westküste Kleinasiens 2017-08-21 mesopotamia is often considered to be the birthplace of law codes in recognition of this fact and motivated by the perennial interest in the topic among assyriologists the 59th rencontre assyriologique internationale was organized in ghent in 2013 around the theme law and dis order in the ancient near east based on papers delivered at that meeting this volume contains twenty six essays that focus on archaeological philological and historical topics related to order and chaos in the ancient near east written by a diverse array of international scholars the contributions to this book explore laws and legal practices in the ur iii old babylonian middle assyrian and neo assyrian periods in mesopotamia as well as in nuzi and the hebrew bible among the subjects covered are the code of hammurabi legal phraseology the archaeological traces of the organization of community life and biblical law the volume also contains essays that explore the concepts of chaos disorder and law order in divinatory texts and literature wide ranging and cutting edge the essays in this collection will be of interest to assyriologists especially members of the international association for assyriology

Deutsches Wörterbuch 1905 karduniaš as the kingdom of the kassites in babylonia was called in ancient times was the neighbor and rival of great powers such as egypt the hittites and assyria but while our knowledge of the latter kingdoms has made huge progress in the last decades the kassites have until recently been largely ignored by modern scholarship recently a number of scholars have embarked on research into different aspects of late bronze age babylonia the desire to share the results of these new investigations resulted in an international conference which was held at munich university in july 2011 the presentations given at this meeting have been revised for publication in the current volume this book gives an overview of current research on the kassites and is the first larger survey of their culture ever an invaluable introduction by kassite expert professor john a brinkman is followed by seventeen specialist contributions investigating different aspects of the kassites these include detailed historical social cultural archaeological and art historical studies concerning the kassites from their first arrival in mesopotamia during the period when a kassite dynasty ruled babylonia c 1595 1155 bc and in the subsequent aftermath concentrating on southern mesopotamia the contributions also discuss kassite relations and presence in neighboring regions the book is completed by a substantial bibliography and a detailed index

Divine Presence and Guidance in Israelite Traditions 2010-07-01 for over a century the danish thinker søren kierkegaard 1813-55 has been at the center of a number of important discussions concerning not only philosophy and theology but also more recently fields such as social thought psychology and contemporary aesthetics especially literary theory despite his relatively short life kierkegaard was an extraordinarily prolific writer as attested to by the 26 volume princeton university press edition of all of his published writings but kierkegaard left behind nearly as much unpublished writing most of which consists of what are called his journals and notebooks kierkegaard has long been recognized as one of history's great journal keepers but only rather small portions of his journals and notebooks are what we usually understand by the term diaries by far the greater part of kierkegaard's journals and notebooks consists of reflections on a myriad of subjects philosophical religious political personal studying his journals and notebooks takes us into his workshop where we can see his entire universe of thought we can witness the genesis of his published works to be sure but we can also see whole galaxies of concepts new insights and fragments large and small of partially or almost entirely completed but unpublished works kierkegaard's journals and notebooks enables us to see the thinker in dialogue with his times and with himself kierkegaard wrote his journals in a two column format one for his initial entries and the second for the extensive marginal comments that he added later this edition of the journals reproduces this format includes several photographs of original manuscript pages and contains extensive scholarly commentary on the various entries and on the history of the manuscripts being reproduced volume 8 of this 11 volume series includes five of kierkegaard's important notebooks journals nb21 through nb25 which cover the period from september 1850 to june 1852 and which show kierkegaard alternately in polemical and reflective postures the polemics emerge principally in kierkegaard's opposition to the increasing infiltration of christianity by worldly concerns a development that in his view had accelerated significantly in the aftermath of the political and social changes wrought by the revolution of 1848 kierkegaard understood the corrupting of christianity to be in the interest of the powers that be and he directed his criticism at politicians the press and especially the danish church itself particularly church officials who claimed to be reformers on the reflective side kierkegaard delves into a number of authors and religious figures some of them for the first time including montaigne pascal seneca savonarola wesley and f w newman these journals also contain kierkegaard's thoughts on the decisions surrounding the publication of the anti climacus writings the sickness unto death and especially practice in christianity kierkegaard's reader gets the sense both of a gathering storm by the close of the last journal in this volume the famous attack on christendom is less than three years away and a certain hesitancy what needs reforming kierkegaard insists is not the doctrine or the church but existences in e lives
