le siège de calais hailed by its author in 1765 as france s première tragédie nationale rolled into paris like a storm pierre laurent de belloy s play about french bravery during the hundred years war 1337 1453 appeared on the heels of france s defeat in the seven years war 1756 1763 le siège de calais was performed throughout europe and published numerous times during the second half of the eighteenth century de belloy emerged as a national hero receiving prizes from louis xv accolades from the city of calais and membership to the prestigious académie française since the french revolution however the popularity of le siège de calais has eclipsed owing to its overt glorification of france s royal machine several hundred years later the play warrants a fresh look from a holistic perspective de belloy s tragedy and the varied responses it provoked many of which are included in this edition offer complex representations of french political history and patriotic sentiment le siège de calais reveals conflicting images of gender roles political debate and family values during the twilight of the ancien régime it also constituted one of the last moments when serious drama asserted its role as a popular force

hidden within age old classic stories lie the hermetic teachings of alchemy and freemasonry explains how the stages of the great work are encoded in both little known and popular stories such as cinderella snow white and little red riding hood reveals the connection between mother goose and important esoteric symbols of the western mystery tradition demonstrates the ancient lineage of these stories and how they originated as the trigger to push humanity toward higher levels of consciousness in his mystery of the cathedrals the great alchemist fulcanelli revealed the teachings of the hermetic art encoded in the sculpture and stained glass of the great cathedrals of europe what he did for churches his disciple bernard roger does here for fairy tales through exhaustive analysis of the stories collected by the brothers grimm perrault and others roger demonstrates how hermetic ideas especially those embodied in alchemy and freemasonry can be found in fairy tales including such popular stories as cinderella snow white sleeping beauty and little red riding hood as well as the tales attributed to mother goose the goose has long been an important esoteric symbol in the western mystery tradition the stories told under the aegis of mother goose carry these symbols and secrets concealed in what hermetic adepts have long called the language of the birds drawing upon the original versions of fairy tales not the sanitized accounts made into children s movies the author reveals how the tales illustrate each stage of the great work and the alchemical iterations required to achieve them he shows how the common motif of a hero or heroine sent in search of a rare object by a sovereign before their wishes can be granted is analogous to the masonic quest for the lost tomb of hiram or the alchemist s search for the fire needed to perform the great work he also reveals how the hero is always aided by a green bird which embodies the hermetic understanding of the seed and the fruit by unveiling the secret teachings within fairy tales roger demonstrates the truly ancient lineage of these initiatory stories and how

they originated as the trigger to push humanity toward higher levels of consciousness

in 1760 the french playwright charles palissot de montenoy wrote les philosophes a scandalous farcical comedy about a group of opportunistic self styled philosophers les philosophes emerged in the charged historical context of the pamphlet wars surrounding the publication of diderot and d alembert s encyclopédie and delivered an oblique but acerbic criticism of the intellectuals of the eighteenth century enlightenment including the likes of diderot and rousseau this book presents the first high quality english translation of the play including critical apparatus the translation is based on olivier ferret s edition and renders the text into iambic pentameter to preserve the character of the original adaptations are further provided of ferret s introduction and notes this masterful and highly accessible translation of les philosophes opens up this polemical text to a non specialist audience it will be a valuable resource to non francophone scholars and students working on the philosophical exchanges of the enlightenment moreover this translation the result of a year long project undertaken by jessica goodman with six of her undergraduate french students expounds the value of collaboration between scholar and student and as such provides a model for other language tutors embarking on translation projects with their students
