wiktor stoczkowski a palaeo anthropologist argues that the theories of human origins developed by archaeologists and physical anthropologists from the early nineteenth century to the present day are structurally similar to western folk theories and to the speculations of earlier philosophers reviewing a remarkable range of thinkers writing in a variety of european languages he makes a convincing argument for this case even though the book criticises the lack of development in theories of human origins its conclusion is optimistic about the power of the scientific approach to deliver more reliable theories but only if the influences of popular discourse on its thinking are properly identified

this volume presents for the first time an in depth analysis of the origins of greek euergetism derived from the greek for benefactor euergetism refers to the process whereby citizens and foreigners offered voluntary services and donations to the polis that were in turn recognised as benefactions in a formal act of reciprocation euergetism is key to our understanding of how city states negotiated both the internal tensions between mass and elite and their conflicts with external powers this study adopts the standpoint of historical anthropology and seeks to identify patterns of behaviour and social practices deeply rooted in greek society and in the long course of greek history it covers more than five hundred years and will appeal to ancient historians and scholars in other fields interested in gift exchange benefactions philanthropy power relationships between mass and elite and the interplay between public discourse and social praxis

this study of greek time before aristotle s philosophy starts with a commentary on his first text the protrepticus we shall see two distinct forms of time emerge one initiatory circular and platonic in inspiration the other its diametrical opposite advanced by aristotle we shall explore this dichotomy through a return to poetic conceptions the tragedians will give us an initial outline of the notion of time in the greek world fate we shall then turn to homer in order to better grasp the complex relations between time and the religious sphere the hero the work of the great theologian hesiod will confirm this initiatory vision later set out in remarkable fashion by nietzsche myths we shall then dive deep into pythagoreanism to complete our account mysteries having understood this current of thought powerfully influenced by the iranian theogony we shall be able to discern its clear differences from the so called ionian current and thus to move away from plato ideology lastly we shall return to the early ionian thinkers thales and anaximander to analyse whether this really was the vision of the world that aristotle adopted in developing the first model of time science in the second volume we shall see the return of the thought of the theologoi within the aristotelian corpus itself and will question our distinction between the being and existence of time free ebook version editions

the early ethical acts of truth telling in ancient greece gradually metamorphosed into acts of self incrimination in monastic times and ultimately into the birth and rise of psychiatry as the foundation of modern penology criminology and criminal justice for foucault self incrimination no longer did the work necessary to quell justice because by the 19th century we wanted to know more than just the fact of wrongdoing we wanted to know who the criminal was not just whether the accused committed the crime but what it was about him that made him commit the crime an avowal of wrong doing was no longer sufficient psychiatric expertise was now necessary and that development marks the birth of discipline and modern criminal justice made so famous by foucault

this book focuses on the evidence for short non epic hexametrical genres as a way of gaining new insights into the variety of their often ritual performance their early history and how poets from homer to theocritus embedded or imitated these genres to enrich their own poems by playing with and sometimes overturning the generic expectations of their audiences or readers in doing so it combines literary and ritual studies to produce a rich and detailed picture of a number of genres performed in temples such as hymns and laments for adonis or in other spaces likewise dedicated to traditional speech acts such as epithalamia oracles or incantations it deals primarily with the recovery of a number of lost or under appreciated hexametrical genres which are usually left out of modern taxonomies of archaic hexametrical poetry either because they survive only in fragments or because the earliest evidence for them dates to the classical period and beyond of central importance will be the surviving hexametrical poets especially those of archaic and hellenistic date who embed or imitate traditional hexametrical genres of shorter duration either to give a recognizable internal structure to a shorter poem or to an episode or speech within a longer one
